### Winter

\*\*Teacher Recommendation Letters - ask early; most teachers limit it to 10 students especially for scholarships

\*\*Reality Store - Friday, February 14 from 8:30-noon. Prep for the event will be upcoming.

- In January, gather tax information for the FAFSA.
- In January or early February, fill out the FAFSA.
- Apply for more scholarships.
- Send in applications for colleges to which you have not yet applied.
- Have your mid-year grades sent to colleges (talk with your school counselor).
- Make sure you are keeping up in your classes!

### Spring

- Decide on a college and notify the admissions office by May 1<sup>st</sup> of your acceptance.
- Notify other colleges who have accepted you that you will not be attending.
- Update your college acceptance status in Family Connection and let your counselor know of your decision. \*\*Please let the high school office know your final decisions concerning your future plans.
- Create a budget to determine your financial needs for the coming school year.
- Determine if you need a student loan. File your application.
- See your doctor for a physical and any necessary vaccinations.
- Complete your housing and meal applications.
- Take Advanced Placement Exams.
- Have your final transcript sent to your college.
- Apply for a summer job.

### Summer

- Notify your college of any scholarships you received.
- If your financial aid package includes work study, you may be responsible for finding a job at college.
- Start your reading assignments for freshman year.
- Take a deep breath. Pack for college!
